Devising new plantation strategy and delinking of forest nurseries-cost norms approval thereof.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. Ft. 1790-2/71(D)2011-12/Vol-VIII (Norms) dated 16<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 on the subject cited above and to say that the cost norms for raising normal as well as tall plants of different species in nurseries in Tribal and Non tribal areas is approved as proposed subject to following conditions:-

- 1) These cost norms will be the upper limit and normally the actual costs/ expenditure should not exceed 80% of these norms as some savings may result due to various reasons like less carriage cost, less cost of polythene bags.
- 2) Wherever possible decomposable bags be used.
- 3) Vermicompost should gradually be made in each nursery instead of buying.
- 4) The workers working in nurseries should be trained in a phased manner so that nursery *Malis* are available in all nurseries.
- 5) Data regarding availability of plants in each nursery in next 5-7 years should be available on departmental website.
- 6) Adequate plants will be made available to public and other departments also, if they want to do plantation on their own. This includes School Children, Yuvak and Mahila Mandals.

- A system to be introduced so that a team from other Circles/HQ 7) visits each nursery every year at least once to certify that plants being given out in that year are of the required quality.
- Quality norms for plants of various species be clearly defined and 8) circulated.
- R&D Division and Nauni University experts should visit some 9) nurseries on regular basis so that further improvement in techniques and systems is possible.
- One state level seminar will be organized on nursery raising every 10) year.

You are, therefore, requested to take further necessary action in the matter accordingly.
