The posts in the category of Assistant Engineer (8 No.) and Junior Engineer (10 No.) have been enhanced from the existing sanctioned strength with a view to bring efficiency in the work of the department and therefore it has been decided that these posts may be filled up by direct recruitment only. Hence, the R&P Rules of these posts shall require amendment accordingly.

The Governor, Himachal Pradesh is further pleased to define the duties and responsibilities of above engineering staff as under:-

- i) All Civil Works more than one lakh whether repair or new work will be scrutinized and technically approved by the engineering staff of the department.
- ii) A panel of Architect and Structural Engineers may be maintained and finalized at Direction Office following transparent process for the works where the services of the Architect and Structural Engineer is required.
- iii) Upto 1 lakh no technical sanction from engineering staff is required. However DFO may take technical help from Departmental Technical staff or technical staff with any other Govt. department, if he feels that the work needs technical help.
- iv) The work from 1 lakh to 10 lakh may be technically approved by AE at Circle level. Tendering award and payment will be made by the DFO and AE will also provide technical supervision and test checks.
- v) The works from Rs. 10 lakhs to 20 Lakh may be technically sanctioned by the XEN. Tendering award and payment may be done by the DFO.

- vi) The works from Rs. 20 lakh and above - Technical sanctions may be accorded by XEN. Tendering and award will be done by the C.F. with help of XEN. Payment and execution to be done by the DFO. XEN/AE to provide supervision and test checks.
- vii) The Financial and administrative powers will remain as of today.
- viii) A panel of architects will be maintained by PCCF (HoFF) to provide architectural help.
- ix) The Executive Engineer/Assistant Engineer may be assigned works other than above by PCCF (HoFF)/PCCF (Admn.) like maintenance of colonies, execution of specific jobs, etc.
- x) A schedule of rate may be prepared by the PCCF (HoFF) taking into consideration the HPPWD and CPWD schedules.

This is in continuation to this department's Notification No. FFE-A(6)-7/2015 dated 20.06.2017.
